SGN (Southern Gas Networks) will be replacing the gas main on Western Road between 6<sup>th</sup> May and 18<sup>th</sup> July.


This means that the road will be closed in the northbound direction. (please see map below).

The Flower Team will be running the plant stall at the church fete.




